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#### **RESOLUTION 2023-01**

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE LIBERTY COVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING THE PRIMARY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE AND PRINCIPAL HEADQUARTERS OF THE DISTRICT; DESIGNATING THE LOCATION OF THE LOCAL DISTRICT RECORDS OFFICE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Liberty Cove Community Development District (the "District") is a local unit of special-purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, being situated entirely within Nassau County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to designate its primary administrative office as the location where the District's public records are routinely created, sent, received, maintained, and requested, for the purposes of prominently posting the contact information of the District's Record's Custodian in order to provide citizens with the ability to access the District's records and ensure that the public is informed of the activities of the District in accordance with Chapter 119, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the District also desires to specify the location of the District's principal headquarters for the purpose of establishing proper venue under the common law home venue privilege applicable to the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the District is statutorily required to designate a local district records office location for the purposes of affording citizens the ability to access the District's records, promoting the disclosure of matters undertaken by the District, and ensuring that the public is informed of the activities of the District in accordance with Chapter 119 and Section 190.006(7), *Florida Statutes*.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE LIBERTY COVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

**SECTION 1.** The District's primary administrative office for purposes of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, shall be located at 2300 Glades Road, Suite 410W, Boca Raton, Florida 33431.

**SECTION 2.** The District's principal headquarters for purposes of establishing proper venue shall be located within Nassau County, Florida.

**SECTION 3.** The District's local records office shall be located at .

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Dear Public Works Director:

The Liberty Cove Community Development District Board of Supervisors ("District") is hereby advising you that it currently has no applicable facilities or programs subject to the needs analysis under sections 403.9301 and 403.9302 and, accordingly, will not be submitting a report for the current reporting period deadline in June 2022. The new law requiring special districts that either own or operate stormwater management systems to create a 20-year needs analysis ("Needs Analysis") of such system(s), with the first analysis due to Clay County by June 30, 2022. Pursuant to its establishing ordinance and Section 190.012(1)(f), Florida Statutes, the District does not and/or will not own and/or operate a stormwater management system prior to the June 30, 2022, submission deadline.

The District acknowledges and agrees that, upon transfer of a stormwater system from the construction to operation phase, the District will perpetually operate, maintain and fund the stormwater system and intends to fund such operational and maintenance activities through the annual levy of maintenance special assessments as authorized under Section 190.021(3), *Florida Statutes*. Moreover, the District agrees that, upon transfer of a stormwater system, the District will create and submit a Needs Analysis of such system(s).
