Discussion ensued regarding scheduling an additional meeting on June 14, 2024 at 10:00 a.m., for financing purposes. Supervisors Matovina, Wood and Howell confirmed their attendance at the June 14, 2024 meeting.

ELEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Board Members' Comments/Requests

A Board Member asked when electing Board Members through the General Election process will begin.

Mr. Haber stated General Elections will not begin until the CDD has been in existence for six years and the CDD has at least 250 qualified electors within the CDD boundaries. A qualified elector is defined as those 18 years and older, whose primary residence is within the CDD, and who are registered to vote in Nassau County. He noted that multiple qualified electors may reside in a single residence. When both conditions are met, the transition to a resident Board will begin, with two Seats up for election at the General Election. Those two Seats would be required to be filled by a qualified elector resident of the CDD. If the Developer or Landowner

still owns the majority of the property, they will control the Landowner Election in the same year, in which three Seats would be elected by the Developer or Landowner.
